# Finals Information

## Scoring

Each team must provide a scorer for all finals.

All Junior games will be centrally timed .

All senior games will be centrally timed for 3 quarters and the buzzer will go to signal the start of the 4th quarter. The final quarter will be individually timed by the scorers, who will advise the umpires to signal the end of the game. Time will be held for all senior games in the 4th quarter.

## General Safety

Please refrain from walking around courts when games are in progress and umpires are in the vicinity. If moving around courts whilst games are underway, please keep an eye on umpires and progress of play so you can avoid collisions. First aid boxes are located in the office.

## Extra time

In the event that the scores are tied at the end of any final, there will be a 1-minute break, during which, substitution or positional changes may be made. The teams change ends and play restarts with the next centre pass. Play continues until one team has a two-goal lead, at which point they are declared the winner.

## 11U Teams

Extra time will be timed for 5 minutes. If one team reaches a two-goal lead within the 5 minutes, play ends and that team is declared the winner. Otherwise, if play ends after five minutes, the winner is the team that is one goal up or if it is a draw, it is the team who made the grand final first is declared the winner.





# Finals Information

## Injury or blood time

If a player is injured or ill, any on-court player may ask the umpire to hold time. In the case of a player who is bleeding or has blood on them, the umpire will hold time when requested, or when they notice blood. Once time has been held, the injured or bleeding player must leave the court, and has 30 seconds to do so. The game restarts without them on the court (either they are replaced, or a position is left vacant). The player should not be treated on the court, but the primary carer may enter the court to assess whether they are able to leave the court within 30 seconds. If the player can not be removed within 30 seconds, the primary carer will inform the umpires, who will extend injury time. Both teams may make any substitutions or team changes within the 30 seconds.

## Grand Finals

All inside grand finals will be timed on the stadium clocks. Instructions for operating the scoreboard clocks will be at each bench. All outside grand finals will be individually timed by the scorers. Games should start at the published time.

Junior games: all quarters are 12 minutes. Breaks between periods are 2 minutes, 3 minutes, and 2 minutes.

Senior games: all quarters are 15 minutes. Breaks between periods are 3 minutes, 4 minutes, and 3 minutes.

When the umpire blows the whistle for the start of the quarter, the timer should be started.

## Player of the match

**For grand finals only:** Umpires should decide the 'player of the match' (in consultation with the scorers if they wish) and write it in the designated space at the bottom of the scoresheet.
