Mixed Roster Rules

Matches

- All players will need to register on PlayHQ to their team. A link and instructions will be sent to your team contact after the team entry is completed. Options for registration include 12 months or 3 months. The 12-month option should be selected by anyone who will be playing both rosters and/or will be playing in other rosters at STNA or some other associations (State League, Sorell roster, Kingston rosters). Those choosing to play just one roster or are unsure if they will continue playing should select the 3-month option.
- 2. Each team must supply their own scorer, who is to remain the scorer for the duration of the match but may change each week. Scorers from each team are to sit together for the duration of the match.
- 3. If your team forfeits, then it is your responsibility to contact the STNA office with sufficient time for your opponents to be informed.

Player eligibility

- 1. Minimum age of 15 years (As at 31st of December).
- 2. Players may only be registered in one team.
- 3. Teams can get fill ins from lower divisions or externally.

Dress Code

- 1. All players need to be wearing matching colours (tops and bottoms). Skirts, shorts or tights can be worn.
- 2. We have spare/clash bibs at the STNA office.
- 3. The roster follows the official Rules of Netball that is, all jewellery must be removed (not taped) and nails must be short (even if gloves are worn). Umpires have the right to refuse players from taking the court if they breach this rule.
- 4. Surgically implanted piercings must be approved by the STNA office before the player takes the court.

Behaviour

- 1. Teams, individual players, coaches and umpires will be expected to behave in a sporting manner.
- 2. They will respect their opponents and show appreciation for good play on both sides.

Points for games

- 4 for a win
- 2 for a loss
- 3 for a draw
- 0 for a forfeit

Male/Female Ratio

NOTE: Rules played in the Creek Road Mixed Roster may vary from other Mixed competitions.

- 1. Male team members can play anywhere on the court but only one male may be in the goal circle i.e. Two males cannot play GD and GK or GS and GA. Otherwise there is no limit- it is OK to have males as WA, C, and WD.
- 2. There must be two males on the team to take the court and no more than three males on the court.

Finals

- 1. Teams playing a player who has already played in another team in the same roster, regardless of division, will automatically forfeit any points receive for the game.
- 2. 3 minimum games needed to play finals for every player (including fill ins). After playing 3 games, fill ins need to register to PlayHQ via team link.
- 3. Drawn finals will be resolved by a 2-goal advantage after swapping ends at full time.
- 4. If a team wishes to play a fill in for finals who do not meet the policies, approval must be granted by the STNA Office.

Court play

- 1. Umpires have the right to send any player from the court for unduly rough play or unsuitable language. Umpires will warn a player and if unsuitable behaviour persists the umpire has the right to send a player from the court. Umpires are requested to put the names of any player sent from the court on the back of the scorecards.
- 2. Any player sent from the court is automatically suspended from playing the following week. If playing the last game of the season, this rule will be applied to the next roster in which the player is participating.
- 3. In the event of a team playing a game with only two males, one sent from the court will automatically stop the team from continuing the game.

- 4. In the event of totally undesirable play, or a deliberate attempt to injure another player, an umpire may use their discretion and send a player from the court without prior warning.
- 5. Please note that suspensions and disqualifications from the roster are at the discretion of the STNA Office.

We are fortunate to have a group of umpires who regularly umpire our Mixed Roster and hope members of teams accord them the appropriate respect.
